ıswers: black, 9, Jıngle Bells, Christmas cracker/bon bon, candy cane, star or angel, red, green & gold

STEP 1- Using brown paper, cut out a square, about 16x16cms. First, fold the paper in half to create a triangle. Next, fold up two points of the triangle to form the reindeer's ears. Be sure to press down to create crisp folds.

STEP 2- Now it's time to add some details. Draw the antlers and eyes on a piece of white paper. Draw a circle on a piece of red paper to create the nose and a bow if you wish. Cut out all of the pieces.

STEP 3- Let's get gluing! Glue on the eyes and nose as well as the optional bow. Then, flip over the reindeer and attach the antlers on the back of the project.

STEP 4- Use a hole punch to make a hole at the top of the head. Attach a piece of string and now your little guy is ready to be hung on the Christmas tree. Hmmm I wonder if you'll create all of Santa's eight reindeer?

CHRISTMAS MARSHMALLOW POPS

- 12 marshmallows
- 250g milk chocolate
- 150g white chocolate
- 25 green mini M&Ms
- 12 red mini M&Ms
- 12 cake pop sticks
- 1. Place each marshmallow onto the top of a cake pop stick.
- 2. Melt the milk chocolate in the microwave for 2-3 mins, stirring every 30 secs.
- 3. Dip each stick into the melted chocolate, allow any excess to drip off and then allow the milk chocolate to set (it will only take a couple of minutes). Stand the cake pop up in a cake pop stand or if you don't have one, a piece of foam or even in a glass.
- $4. \\ \textit{Meanwhile, melt white chocolate in the microwave for 2 mins, stirring every 30 secs.}$
- 5. Using a teaspoon, place a dollop of white chocolate onto the top of each marshmallow and use your spoon to push some of the chocolate over the edge.
- 6. Working quickly, place 2 green mini M&Ms and 1 red mini M&M onto the white chocolate.
- 7. If gifting, tie a ribbon around the base of each marshmallow and wrap with cellophane.
