## Guest speakers

We are delighted to welcome **Emeritus Professor George Yeoh**, Harry Perkins Institute of Medical Research, to share his work on the development of a blood test to determine liver disease severity, offering a non-invasive alternative to traditional biopsy methods; and **Dr Sunaina Parsons**, Institute for Respiratory Health, to share her work on tracking heart and health risks in people with cystic fibrosis.

Both are supported through the WA Cystic Fibrosis Research Collaborative Program, a co-funding partnership between the Future Health Research and Innovation (FHRI) Fund and Cystic Fibrosis WA (CFWA), in collaboration with Conquer CF (CCF). The program reflects a shared commitment to advancing knowledge, research, and innovation that improve outcomes for people with CF.
