Types of Gifts You Can Leave

There are several ways to include a charitable gift in your Will:



1

A Percentage of Your Estate

You can nominate a percentage of your estate after all expenses have been settled.



2

A Specific Sum of Money

You can choose a fixed amount to donate to charity.



3

The Residual Estate

This is the remainder of your estate after family, friends, and other beneficiaries have been provided for.



4

Specific Assets

You may choose to gift assets such as:

- Property
- Shares or securities
- Life insurance proceeds
- Vehicles
- Other valuable items

Leaving a percentage of your estate or residual gift are among the most common forms of charitable bequests. There is no minimum or maximum amount, CFWA will be grateful for gifts of all sizes.

Suggested Will Wording

We recommend obtaining independent legal advice when preparing or updating your Will. The following sample wording may be provided to your solicitor:

“

“I give [Insert details of your gift] to Cystic Fibrosis WA Inc of Suite C, 11 Aberdare Rd, Nedlands WA 6009 (ABN 19156339182), to be applied for its general charitable purposes.

I declare that the receipt of an authorised officer of the organisation shall be a sufficient discharge to my Executors.”

Please note that this wording should be reviewed by your legal adviser to ensure it aligns with your intentions and circumstances.

This wording is adapted from the bequest clause used by Cystic Fibrosis WA.
